

I was not a particularly impressive child. I wasn't gifted or even very interested in many subjects at school. I wasn't exactly popular, and I wasn't involved in clubs or sports or any other afterschool activities. I wasn't tone deaf, but I had very little, real musical ability. I wasn't interested in being social and I showed no promise as a leader. With the exception of the occasional assignment that required me to be out front—like a science project or a book report—I was content to live life out of the limelight, blending in with the crowd, flying under the radar. Invisibility was my goal. Being singled out from the other students was the greatest catastrophe I could imagine.

Perhaps no arena of school life brought this fear to the forefront quite as much as P.E. class. Some of you are already tensing up remembering your own experiences; I can feel it as I wrote the words, P.E. class. The athletically challenged or exceptionally introverted understand the panic, embarrassment, and awkwardness of these dreaded words: "Okay, kids, let's line up and choose teams!" It was a regular terror. The P.E. teacher would assign "team captains," who would then pick the players for their teams. How I hated that practice. Why? Because inevitably, I was "that kid;" the one last or nearly last to be chosen.

For me, finally being *chosen* not only brought a feeling of tremendous relief but also a weighty pressure. As intimidated as I was by the lack of skill I often had for whatever game we were playing, there was also a drive to prove my teammates wrong.



Despite their doubts, I wanted to rise to the challenge others thought I was unable to meet.

Throughout Scripture, we find the word "chosen" used to denote one who is examined, preferred by others, and selected by God. Throughout the Bible, we read of individuals who were chosen by God, often to do something challenging or seemingly impossible:

- Joseph was chosen to endure betrayal and prison to eventually rise to prominence and power, enabling him to not only save his family but an entire nation during a season of famine.
- Elijah was chosen to demonstrate confident faith in God, standing up to the evil King Ahab and wicked Queen Jezebel, leading to an ultimate victory against the followers of Baal.
- Queen Esther was divinely chosen to boldly speak to the king, reveal the wicked schemes of Haman, and save her people from total annihilation.
- Mary was chosen by God, favored to be the virgin mother and carry the Hope and Salvation of all mankind in her young womb.

As we consider the world surrounding our children, we realize the season in which we serve is not without challenge. Unlike any other time, the church is contending with a rising hostility toward the Gospel, the spread of secular culture, the influence of the media on society, the busyness and distraction of parents, and the collapse of the family, among many other challenges. The children of our families and churches are spending their formative years in peculiar, hard times that cause even the most committed of us to wonder, "Am I up for this challenge?"

Make no mistake: YOU WERE CHOSEN. I Peter 2:9 (NIV) reminds us, "But you are a *chosen* people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light."

You have been *chosen* by God to serve Him during this time for His kingdom purposes. He placed you in your family, church, ministry, and community to wage war on the schemes of the enemy and engage in the conflict for the hearts and minds of a generation.

At Chosen, the 2023 Institute of Children's Ministry, we will—

- seek God for personal renewal and refreshing
- renew our commitment to echo God's love for this generation of children
- learn strategies, techniques, and tools for declaring His truth in relevant ways to kids
- discover how to battle the schemes of the enemy to distract and confuse our children
- return home to partner with God to see His purposes fulfilled for this generation.


