Growing up in a small Pentecostal church exposed me to many traditions and a rich heritage when I was younger. I remember being the first one to church and usually the last to leave because my dad was tasked with the responsibility of making sure all the lights were turned on and off and all the doors were unlocked and locked. We had Sunday morning services, Sunday evening services, Wednesday evening services, and, of course, special events and revival services that were scheduled multiple times throughout the year.

Our Sunday evening services were a bit more casual and laid back, and usually, the people in attendance were the tried-andtrue members, the ones who were also there every time the doors were open. Many Sunday nights after we'd sing a few hymns from the legendary Blue Book and some choruses, the preacher would always make a certain statement. He or she would say in a commanding type of way, "Somebody testify!" I remember the momentary pause and then people would begin to share their story. There were, of course, those members who just wanted to say, "I thank the Lord for my salvation," and they would echo those words every week. As the delayed pause continued,

more people would share. I would hear stories of God's provision, healing, grace, and blessings in the lives of my church family.

As I got older and made a confession of faith, I started to feel the weight in the awkward pause after the request for a testimony. Should I share something? What would I share? Do I even have a testimony? It felt as if the weight of everyone's eyes and ears would be on me, and it was just too much.

What I didn't realize at the time was how much those stories would shape my own. I heard God's character and faithfulness echoed week after week, and I saw it lived out in the lives around me. All our stories meshed into a greater story—it was God's story.

Psalm 48:13-14 (MSG) says: "...Then you can tell the next generation detail by detail the story of God, Our God forever, who guides us till the end of time."

Testimony is a powerful tool that we have as believers. It gives us confidence, strengthens our faith, and enables us to be witnesses with the power of the Holy Spirit.

As we minister to kids, we can see and trust the bigger picture and know that God's character is unchanging. His story doesn't change. In fact, it is our story, and it is the story for the children we minister to also. We are all part of a story together. Story is powerful and our kids need it so that they can have deep roots and connections that tie them to God's character and His purposes for their lives.

Your testimony is a powerful reminder to children that God doesn't just work in the past or future—He's actively shaping their story right now. Culture today is demanding on our children, pushing them to conform to trends, opinions, and values that often stray from God's truth, leaving them in need of guidance and a solid foundation in His word. Testifying to God's work in our lives is an act of resistance against a culture that undermines faith, reminding children that they can stand strong in the face of worldly pressures.

God is calling each of us to TESTIFY and share His story. His story is our story, and the story of future generations to come. Let's share it!


